THE GOLF COURSES

Joondalup Resort (Thursday 18th May)

Few golf courses offer the dramatic contrasts, scenic beauty and sheer golfing challenge of Joondalup Resort's 27-hole course. Designed by Robert Trent Jones Jnr, it has a tough, uncompromising layout, with great variation in setting and style. This spectacular course features dense bushland, dramatic limestone quarries and picturesque lakes, to delight and challenge all golfers. www.joondalupresort.com.au

Mount Lawley Golf Club - MLGC (Friday 19th May)

MLGC is a private club established in 1928 and located only 5km north of Perth. The Championship course is picturesque, undulating and set in 79 hectares (173 acres) of original bush. The skyline of Perth's CBD can be seen from many fairways and from the clubhouse which was built in the traditional 'Mt Lawley' style. www.mlgc.org

PLAY & SOCIAL EVENTS

The tournament is a two-day event, however the 2017 format will enable players to participate in a single day's play should time or travel needs dictate. Registration will start from 11.00am on the 18th and 7.00am on the 19th. Day 1 will be a 4-ball Ambrose Teams event and Day 2 a Stableford event (registered handicap and Callaway sub-categories). An informal happy hour and barbecue dinner will be hosted after the first day's play at Joondalup to award the day's on-course prizes and novelties (long drive, nearest the pin, etc). A gala presentation lunch will be held on Day 2 at MLGC to present the major trophies for the Stableford competition and that day's on-course prizes. Guests and non-playing partners are most welcome to attend both functions. On-course refreshments will be provided on both days.

This popular event will be oversubscribed, and we recommend early registration (online link on the APPEA conference website).

FORMAT

Day 1 - 2017 AOGT Ambrose Team Challenge

Golfers or sponsoring companies may nominate their teams of four, or the Committee will be happy to allocate individual players into teams.

Day 2 - Individual Stableford

DIVISION 1: APPEA Trophy - for golfers with a current GA or equivalent international handicap (proof may be required). Participants compete for both the APPEA Trophy, and also within their flight for the FLIGHT TROPHIES (see below).

DIVISION 2: Earl Abbot Cup - for golfers without a recognised handicap. Participants compete for the Cup under a Callaway scoring system, as well as against opponents within their flight.

LADIES' DIVISION: The AOGT features a separate Ladies' Division. Ladies with a current GA or equivalent handicap are also eligible to win the APPEA Trophy.

FLIGHT TROPHIES: Each flight will comprise eight golfers of similar handicaps playing for perpetual trophies donated by past and present APPEA members and named after Australian Oil and Gas fields.

TRANSPORTATION

Joondalup Resort is 25km north of Perth while MLGC is 5km northeast. The AOGT Committee will endeavor to assist visiting golfers to get together to share taxis based on their hotel location.
