

## APPEA Conference Mentor Program – Overview & Application Form

From 27-30 May, the Australian Petroleum Production & Exploration Association (APPEA) will be holding its flagship event in Brisbane. The premier gathering of the upstream oil and gas industry, APPEA 2019, will take place at the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre and will attract the key leaders and players in the industry.

Following the success of the inaugural program in 2018, APPEA will be hosting a Mentor Program, proudly sponsored by BHP. The **APPEA 2019 Mentor Program** will aim to encourage, enable and empower undergraduate students by linking them with successful peer role models.

- Participate in an APPEA video interview used for conference marketing purposes and post their APPEA 2019 mentee experiences on their own social media channels; and
- Provide feedback on the Mentor Program to APPEA Events representative, post event (verbal interview and/or written email).
